

## Senior Exit Presentation

Seniors...This is your BIG CHANCE. This is your "Time in the spotlight". This is your opportunity to leave a lasting impression on Black River Falls High School. Here it is....the SENIOR EXIT Presentation....

WHO: Every senior will participate in our senior exit presentation process. Each student will provide answers to 5 questions about the high school experience to their advising group, faculty advisor and community member. Your parents also will be invited to hear about your accomplishments.

WHAT: The senior exit presentation is a series of 5 questions/answers which you will thoughtfully and eloquently share with your audience. Your advisor may ask you these questions directly (listed below) or you can respond using a format that you select. We just want you to be prepared and have previously practiced your responses.

WHERE/WHEN: The senior presentation process will take place in your advising classroom. We may pair up two advising groups together if senior numbers are low in a specific advising group. You will be giving your senior exit presentation on **Wednesday, May 15, 2019** during our morning advising session.

WHY: You have numerous fantastic experiences and lessons that you have obtained throughout the last four years. Our faculty and your peers are interested in hearing your story and learning from your successes and failures. As a future productive member of society, it is also important for you to practice sharing your opinions in an organized and well-rehearsed fashion.

WHAT SHOULD THIS LOOK LIKE: No one presentation will look the same. Each presentation must include the answers to the 5 listed questions, but how you share this information is up to you. Students could utilize newspaper clippings, pictures, medals, recommendation letters, sample projects, power points, scrapbooks, presentation boards, or visuals that convey the message you are looking to answer. The presentation should last a minimum of 5 minutes to a maximum time limit of 15 minutes. Presenters are asked to stand in the front of the classroom and should be dressed appropriately. A completed resume will be turned into your advisor.

- 1) Please share your accomplishments and achievements of the last four years of high school. These examples should include both academics and extra-curricular activities.
- 2) Please reflect on your experiences in the high school. What steps did you take to successfully reach your goal of graduation?
- 3) What are your future plans? Again, how will you achieve these goals?
- 4) What advice would you share with underclassmen to make their high school years the best they can be?
- 5) Finally, in thinking back over the last four years, what "special moments" will you never forget?
